Custom Benefits EXAMPLES



- Sobi convened a virtual advisory board to determine the educational & resource needs of NICU families related to RSV. This was a 30 day online commitment and the feedback gleaned informed all departments including marketing, advocacy, and R&D.
- NPA (National Perinatal Association) partnered with NPN to develop online continuing education courses on providing psychosocial support to NICU families. Courses for bedside nurses, neonatal fellows, and maternity care physicians have been created and are co-facilitated with NPN members as instructors myperinatalnetwork.org
- NANN (National Association of Neonatal Nurses) collaborated with NPN to review the parent-facing portions of their discharge planning kit for neonatal nurses babystepstohome.com
- CHEST (American College of Chest Physicians) contracted NPN to co-develop educational materials for pulmonologists and parents about RSV.
- WaterWipes partnered with NPN to launch their new Pure Foundation Fund, a bursary fund in the USA and Canada which recognizes the work of healthcare professionals in maternal-infant care.
- Prolacta Bioscience held a live webinar on human donor milk.
