Stress Disorders in Pediatrics

Stephanie Vaughan, Heather Tanner, & Brittney Gray Studies suggest that 80% of ill or injured children and their families experience some traumatic stress reactions following a medical trauma. Many children who have spent time in the NICU are at an elevated risk for exposure to Acute Stress Disorder, Pediatric Medical Traumatic Stress Disorder (PMTS), and Post Traumatic Stress Disorder. Stress disorders not only impact the patient, but also the family. 87% of patients and 69% of caregivers have experienced PMTS but most do not know what PMTS is. Additionally, PMTS directly impacts those served by the NPN's member organizations especially ones that provide peer support.
